### **Downtown Development Authority (DDA)**

Term: 3 years Meets: 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the Month at 6:30 PM at City Hall

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier or have an interest in a business or property located within the DDA District

Description: The DDA board members consist of the Mayor and local residents/ business owners who have an interest in the development of the downtown district. The Board function is to help create an attractive business district that meets the need of the community.

### **Flood & Erosion Committee**

Term: 3 Years Meets: 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of Every Month at 7:00 PM at Water Tower

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier

Description: The Flood commission consists of a representative from Council along with local residents. The mission of the Luna Pier Flood and Erosion Protection Committee is to maintain an active, knowledgeable committee that will strive to keep all residents of Luna Pier safe from lake flooding due to our City being on the Great Lake Erie. Their motto is "Flood Protection for All".

### **Housing Committee**

Term: 5 Years Meets: 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the Month at the Luna Pier Housing

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier

Description: The Housing Committee consists of a representative from Council along with members of the community. The Committees basic function is to develop policy and procedures for the housing.

### **Parks & Recreation**

Description: The Parks & Recreation committee consists of a representative from Council along with members of the community who have an interest in promoting and improvement of parks and recreational facilities and events.

### **Planning Commission/EDC**

Term: 3 Years Meets: 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of Every Month at 4:00 PM at City Hall

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier

Description: The Planning Commission board consists of a representative from Council along with local residents. The boards basic function is to make recommendations to City Council on land use policies and ordinances.

### **Salary Commission**

Term: 3 years Meets: On a as Need Basis

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier

Description: The Salary Commission consists of members of the Community. They review increase/ decrease in wages for elected officials

### **Tax Board of Review**

Term: 3 Years Meets: 1/2 day in July, 1/2 day in December, 3 1/2 Days in March

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier

Description: The Tax Board of Review consists of the City Assessor and members of the community who have an interest in determining whether an assessment is fair and correct. This Board has the power to revise, correct, change, alter, modify or confirm any assessment in whole as per legislation.

### **Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA)**

Term: 3 years Meets: On a as Need Basis at City Hall

Requirements: Citizen of the City of Luna Pier

Description: The Zoning Board of Appeals consists of a representative from City Council and members of the Community. The Board is the advisory body for the City for the hearing of special use and variation petitions.
