

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Luna Pier Planning Commission has the responsibility and is empowered by the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, Michigan Public Act No. 33 of 2008, to make and adopt the City of Luna Pier Master Plan to guide the physical development of the City and to amend the Plan as needed, and

WHEREAS, the City of Luna Pier Planning Commission provided required notices of its intent to prepare a Master Plan on May 5, 2009, September 22, 2009, October 7, 2009 and engaged in an extensive public involvement and discovery process, and

WHEREAS, the City of Luna Pier Planning Commission made careful and comprehensive studies of present conditions and developed a Master Plan that addresses long-term land use and infrastructure issues, and

WHEREAS, the City of Luna Pier Planning Commission and Luna Pier City Council jointly held a meeting to consider major Master Plan elements and discuss priorities related to Master Plan implementation on November 24, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the City of Luna Pier Planning Commission formally provided a proposed Master Plan to the Luna Pier City Council for review on January 14, 2010 and the Luna Pier City Council subsequently approved distribution of the Master Plan, and

WHEREAS, Representatives from the City of Luna Pier made a presentation before the Monroe County Planning Commission on the proposed Master Plan, and on March 10, 2010, the Monroe County Planning Commission provided its approval, and

WHEREAS, the Luna Pier Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed Master Plan on April 27, 2010 with appropriate public notice, and
