- 5. Old Business:
 - A. Council Rep report: Jim Gardner

- A. Sill Test Project Update each member report on their area of responsibility
 - We all basically have the same report on our areas. The sand comes and goes depending on the direction of the wind. We are all catching some sand, but it moves around to the north or south depending on the wind and wave action.
 - Fred Zibbel showed us some pictures of the sills in front of his and his neighbors homes. The ice has pushed 38 sills to quite an angle. We will need to address this in the near future.
- B. Update on Epoxy/caulk for steel wave deflectors:
 - We will need to figure out how to get the deflectors cleaned out of debris before epoxy can be put in. Will residents do it, or will we have to pay to have it done?
 - We will need to figure out how many tubes of Epoxy we will need to purchase for this project. 1 tube will do 6 to 7 seams.
