- 5. Old Business:
  - A. Council Rep report: Jim Gardner
    - No Report
  - B. Vice Chair Report: Ric Murray
    - The quote from Kennedy Industries for updating the control panel at Forester and the rail assembly on N. 6th St. is still not in.
    - The pumps in Allen Cove are installed and operating well.
  - C. Tresurers Report: Robin Walton
    - In account 100, Old Millage, we have a total of \$31,068.83
    - In account 105, New Millage, we have a total of \$58,129.05. The adjustments were made from last month for West Equipment and Kennedy Industries. A Consumers Energy bill for \$116.47 and Menards bill for \$59.09.

- CD amount is \$225,036.61 for a FEP account total of \$314,234.49.
- C. Chair Report: Stacy Grimes
  - The work on Allen Cove wall between the cylinders is moving forward. They are still working on it and it should be done by Thanksgiving. Council approved about \$68,000 for this work to be done.
  - Discussion took place about the Muddy Creek flow at the northwest point of the city, between Allen Cove and Toledo Beach. Mayor Davison sent an email to Kathy David (DEQ -Department of Environmental Quality) regarding this situation. We will need to make a presentation to the DEQ about this.
