

Welcome to the City of Luna Pier

Luna Pier is well known for our beautiful public beach, lake pier, great fishing, lighthouse facilities, bike and walking lanes, charming parks, local spots for delicious fare and libations, live music, and amazing views of Great Lake Erie.

Due to our growing popularity as a destination location, our efforts are ongoing to preserve the relaxing quality of life for our residents, provide an inviting and delightful experience for our visitors, and properly care for and maintain our captivating beach, pier, and lighthouse facilities.

With those efforts in mind, please note the below enhancements to public parking in Luna Pier.

PAY-BY-PLATE PARKING:

Paid Public Parking now requires the vehicle license plate to register.
Displaying a permit is not required.

TWO CONVENIENT WAYS TO PAY-BY-PLATE:

1. **Parking Payment Kiosk** (located near beach)
 - Follow prompts, enter license plate (card, bills, coins)
2. **"Passport Parking" Mobile App** (get alerts and extend time remotely)
 - Download, register, enter license plate and zone (card only)

NEW RATES ON PEAK DAYS IN PEAK SEASONS:

Summer Peak Season | May 1 through September 30:

\$2/Hour Mon - Thur

\$4/Hour Fri, Sat, Sun; Non-weekend Holidays from 9a - 7p (then \$2)

Walleye Peak Season | October-November and March-April

\$4/Hour 6p - 6a Nightly

PAID PUBLIC PARKING PERMITTED LOCATIONS:

Lots/Zones posted "Paid Parking Required" (Blue P Sign):

48101 - Pier Lot

48102 - Lighthouse Lot

48103 - All Luna Pier Rd. parallel parking (where posted)

48104 - All Harold Dr. parallel parking (where posted)

48105 - City Hall Lot

PARKING PROHIBITED (VIOLATORS SUBJECT TO TICKET/TOW):

All business, restaurant, and church lots as posted.

All residential areas, side streets, and street ends.

Anywhere outside of the "Paid Parking Required" lots and zones.

ENFORCEMENT:

Enforcement is now maintained digitally by mobile device and provides real-time compliance by plate number.

FINES:

Parking Permit Violations are now \$30, rising to \$50 if not paid within 5 days.

Other traffic and parking fines vary by violation according to city ordinance.

PUBLIC BOAT LAUNCH:

Currently, there are no changes to the boat launch parking process or permit fees.

RESIDENTS ONLY ANNUAL PARKING STICKER:

As always, obtained at City Hall. Requires a current Vehicle Registration with Luna Pier address for each vehicle.

PLEASE REGARD:

Follow all posted rules. Take what you bring. Respect residents and private property.

Note high pedestrian activity & enforced low speed limits.
