Are you planning on visiting Luna Pier prior to August 2024?

Here are some things that you should know:

- Access to and from Luna Pier is constrained as the Luna Pier Road overpass over I-75 is closed and is currently being reconstructed. Construction is currently estimated to be completed around July 1, 2024.
 - I-75 Ramps to Luna Pier Road are currently open, but ramp closures are expected and may change.
 - Note: The EB/WB Luna Pier ramp to SB I-75 is expected to be closed 3/25/24
 7:00am until 5/7/24 5:00pm
- As access to and from Luna Pier is constrained our City Council, Fire Department and Police Department are concerned about the safety of our residents and visitors. Therefore, the Freedom Festival (July 1st) and Farmers Market (typically scheduled on Wednesdays) have been put on hold for 2024. For this reason, there are also no organized events planned for the April 8th Solar Eclipse.
 - The main town area of Luna Pier is just over a mile and is landlocked with Lake Erie on its eastern border and I-75 as its western border, and Whitewood Creek on the south border. Other than I-75, the only other outlet is north on Harold Drive (25MPH) to Gaynier to Cousino.

The City of Luna Pier welcomes visitors to continue to visit our local businesses, beautiful Lake Erie beach, and Pier which offers great views and fishing opportunities. Many local businesses have free parking available for their customers. There is an hourly charge for parking in city lots and streets near downtown and the pier. Pay-by-plate parking is available via kiosks (cash/credit) or via the Passport app.

Best routes entering Luna Pier:

- From the South: Travel north on I-75 to Exit 6 (Luna Pier); turn right (east).
- From the North: Travel south on I-75 to Exit 5 (Erie Road); turn left (east) and take ramp to enter NB I-75 to Exit 6 (Luna Pier)
- From the West: From Dixie (M-125) there are several options:
 - $\circ~$ East on Erie Road and then take I-75 North to Exit 6 (Luna Pier).
 - Travel East/Northeast on Cousino, turn right (east) on Gaynier, right (south) on Harold Dr. (25MPH)

- East on South Otter Creek Rd turn right (south) on Cousino, left (east) on Gaynier, right on Harold Dr. (25MPH)
- From the East: You need a boat! 😌

Best routes leaving Luna Pier (effective March 25th):

- To the North: Luna Pier Road to NB I-75 ramp.
- To the South (until 3/24): Luna Pier to NB I-75 ramp to S. Otter Creek (Exit 8) turn left and then left on SB I-75 ramp.
- To the South or West: Go north on Harold Drive (25MPH), left (west) on Gaynier to Cousino Road. Go left on Cousino Road head southwest to Dixie Hwy (M-125).
 Southbound turn left on Dixie (M-125) and South I-75 is accessible by heading East on Erie Road.
