The City of Luna Pier, Michigan and the Luna Pier Volunteer Fire Department (LPVFD) would like to thank Michigan Gas Utilities, in partnership with Wisconsin Public Service Foundation for awarding the LPVFD a Rewarding First Responders grant in the amount of \$2,000. The city was notified it was being awarded the grant on July 25, 2024

This generous grant will enable the LPVFD to fund one new Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and cover the cost of approximately one third of a second unit. Our current AED units will be discontinued and ineligible for support in the very near future. As such, the award of this grant will strongly support our efforts to obtain new, modern AED units that are compatible with the Luna Pier Police Department and with Monroe County, Michigan ambulance services.

The City of Luna Pier continues to make every effort to ensure its emergency responders have the equipment they need to protect its citizens and the visitors to our community. The generosity of Michigan Gas Utilities and the Wisconsin Public Service Foundation has provided a great service to Luna Pier and the LPVFD with this grant.
